PADI National Geographic Advanced Open Water Diver

If you've already learned the basic theory and skills of diving during a PADI Open Water Diver course, our PADI National Geographic Advanced Open Water Diver course gives you the chance to increase your experience, become more confident in the water and earn a certification to dive to 30 meters. Exploration Dive: (Required) As part of the National Geographic Diver course, you must complete an "Exploration Project" where you draw, photograph or video parts of your dive and then document it on the surface.
