## MARINE ENVIRONMENTAL COURSE INFORMATION

Thank you for your inquiry into the Marine Ecology Course with Tamar Taylor from Coral Divers. The adventure begins here. This is a super way to identify what you are seeing under the sea! Increase your knowledge and familiarise yourself with the common species seen on the Sodwana Bay Reefs. There will be corals, and other interesting marine invertebrates and loads of fish. You are likely to see things you have never noticed before! You will become more aware of the biological aspects of the marine environment by the presentations and guided tours of its ecology and biodiversity.

### **The Marine Environmental Experience – R900.00**

This course consists of the following:

1. Three informative presentations (Each presentation is one and a half hours)
2. Three guided sea dives
3. PADI PIC is optional at an additional R300.00 – PADI Project Aware Specialty

This course is run over two or three days. (Presentations will take place at Coral Divers in the evenings and the guided dives will follow the next morning) Accommodation and gear hire are not included in the course price.



Tamar Taylor will be your lecturer and dive guide. She was born in Israel in 1971, grew up and was educated in Israel and enrolled in the Israeli Army for 2 ½ years as a wildlife guide in the desert including snorkelling and Diving trips to the Red Sea. Tamar has been a diving instructor since 1993 and has a B.Sc degree in Marine Environmental Sciences. She has travelled, dived and sailed in the Red Sea, Mediterranean, Australia, New-Zealand, the Seychelles and South Africa.
